



## Shared Computer Activation



In September 2014, Microsoft enabled Shared Computer Activation (SCA) mode in Office 365 which enables multiple Office 365 ProPlus users to share the same hardware in the following three scenarios:

- Customer dedicated self-hosted (on-premise)
- Dedicated third-party hosted
- Windows Azure environment

The shared computer activation feature is notable for organisations that don't necessarily provide dedicated machines for each end user. It's now possible to share a computer or a virtual machine with Office 365 solutions among multiple users. That capability is available across all of Microsoft's product offerings with regard to Office 365 ProPlus, Project Pro for Office 365, or Visio Pro for Office 365.

What this essentially means is that any Office 365 customer licensed with Office ProPlus, E3 and above has rights to run office on a Remote Desktop Server. Previously, businesses could not use that right on a shared hosted platform such as IaaS.
